
How to find your way around the Bible...

Look out for the **READ** sign. It tells you what Bible bit to read.



So, if the notes say... READ John 20v30 ...this means chapter 20 and verse 30 ...and this is how you find it.





DAY 3 THE ONE O'CLOCK MIRACLE




John 4v46-54
