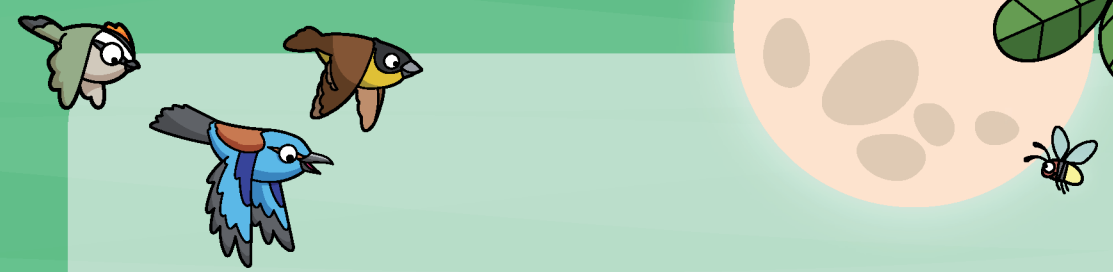

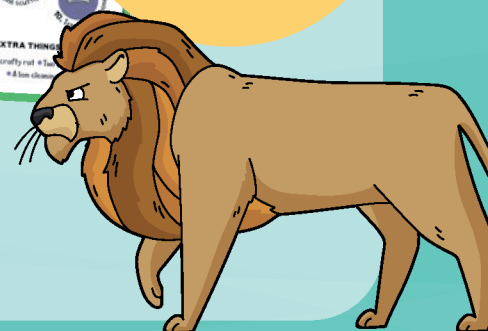

LEAVING GOD'S GARDEN

1. READ

God said Adam and Eve could eat any fruit in God's perfect garden, except the fruit from one special tree.

One day God's enemy – disguised as a sneaky snake – told Eve she could eat the fruit from the special tree and be like God. Eve trusted the sneaky snake instead of trusting God. She ate the fruit and gave some to Adam.

Because they had disobeyed God, suddenly Adam and Eve knew things weren't good and right any more. They tried to hide from God. But God knew what they had done.

TRUST

1. READ

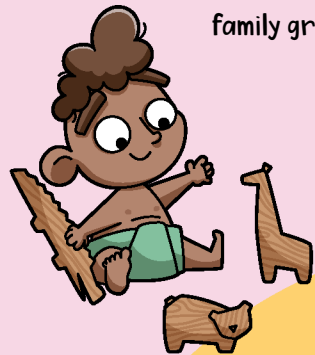
God had promised Abraham and Sarah that their family would grow to be as many as the stars in the sky and the sand on the seashore. Now, that's a lot!

THE DISCIPLES

FACT FILE

As well as Peter and Andrew, Jesus had other disciples who followed him – twelve all together. Their names were:

Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Nathanael, Matthew, Thomas, James (another one!), Thaddeus, Simon and Judas.

1. READ

Time passed, and Jesus grew into a man. One day, he saw two brothers called Peter and Andrew. They were fishermen and had been out all night without catching a single little fishy. Jesus stepped into their boat and said, "Let down your nets for a catch".

Peter said, "We already tried all night. But because you say so, I'll try again." As soon as he let down the nets, they filled with so many splishy, splashy fish that the nets began to break! Peter and Andrew couldn't believe it! They called their friends James and John to help bring all the fish to the shore.

Then Jesus said to them, "Come and follow me, and I will make you fishers of people". The brothers left everything and followed Jesus.

Fishers of people? That sounds strange! Jesus meant that Peter and Andrew would tell people all about him – and instead of bringing fish into a boat, they would bring people into God's wonderful family.

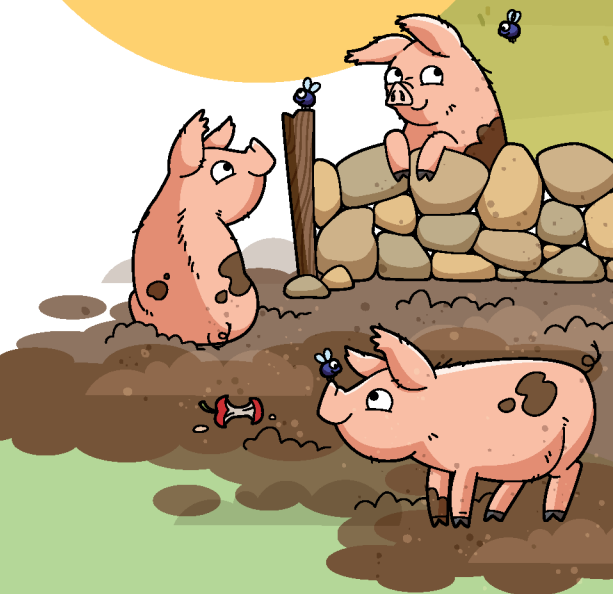

1. READ

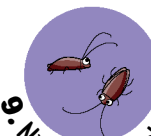

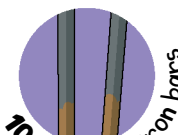
