
7 So Jesus, **GOD'S** Son, did all these **AMAZING**


The **BAD** guys got him. They nailed him to a cross

Jerusalem and went











to the

**Peter**   was kind of in charge, and when everyone got together (there were about **120** people by now) he'd  get up and do a **LITTLE** speech.





<sup>1, 2, 3...</sup>

I missed someone. **Judas**. (Not the one in the list,  another one.) Judas was the one who let Jesus down.

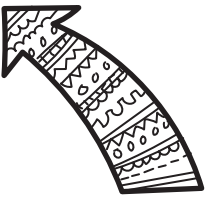
**HE** was the one who told the **bad** guys where they could find Jesus, all because they gave him a bag of silver.
