

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


Fold the paper in half.

Fold the top left-hand corner into the centre.




Fold one flap upwards.

Fold one flap up from the bottom.




Turn the paper over and fold the second flap upwards.





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Passover recipes

Traditional charoset

This recipe makes 20, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon servings. The charoset will keep for three days when it is refrigerated.

Ingredients:

75g or ³/₄ cup walnuts

1/4 large cooking apple

Apple juice to moisten

2 level teaspoons cinnamon

2 level teaspoons sugar

Mince the walnuts and apple in a food processor. Moisten with the apple juice. Flavour with cinnamon and sugar. The consistency should be that of mortar.

Passover cheese balls

Ingredients:

2 eggs, separated

225g cottage cheese

2 tablespoons sugar, optional

1/2 teaspoon salt, if no sugar

4 tablespoons matzo meal

2 tablespoons melted butter, optional

Apple sauce, sugar-cinnamon or sour cream, optional

Beat the egg whites until stiff. Mix the cheese, egg yolks, and sugar or salt. Stir in enough matzo meal to make a batter thick enough to work with your hands. Fold in butter and egg whites. Leave to stand for 30 minutes. Make small balls and drop into boiling water. When they rise to the top, they are done. Serve with apple sauce, sugar-cinnamon or sour cream.

Jewish cheese blintzes

These may be prepared in advance and chilled, ready to bake. Alternatively, you may like to encourage the children to prepare them. This recipe makes 12 blintzes.

Ingredients:

2 cups ricotta cheese

3 tablespoons softened cream cheese

¹/₄ cup sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

3 eggs

1 cup milk

Pancake mix (shaker bottle is easiest)

2 tablespoons melted margarine or butter

Sour cream and strawberry jam (optional)

To prepare the filling, use a small mixer bowl to combine the ricotta cheese, cream cheese, sugar and vanilla. Beat at medium speed until smooth. Cover and chill until ready to use.

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Prepare the pancake mix according to the instructions on the bottle, then shake until smooth. Make the mixture fairly runny. Heat the frypan. For each pancake, pour about $\frac{1}{4}$ cup batter into the hot, prepared pan. Immediately tilt the pan to coat the bottom evenly with a thin layer. When the pancakes are cooked, remove from the pan and stack the pancakes between sheets of baking paper.

Heat an oven to 325°F/160°C/Gas Mark 3. Grease a 13 x 9 inch glass baking dish with 1 teaspoon of melted margarine. Spoon two rounded tablespoons of filling into the centre of each pancake. Fold two sides over the filling and fold up the ends to form a rectangle. Place the blintzes in a prepared dish and brush with the remaining margarine (*). Bake for 20 to 25 minutes or until heated through. Serve with sour cream and strawberry jam, if desired.


* NOTE: At this point, the blintzes may be covered tightly and refrigerated several hours or overnight until ready to bake. Uncover, then proceed as the recipe directs.

Unleavened bread

Ingredients:

3 cups self-raising flour 1½ teaspoons salt 90g margarine or butter ½ cup milk ½ cup water Extra flour

Sift the flour and salt into a bowl. Rub the margarine into the flour until the mix resembles fine bread crumbs and are even in size. Make a well in the centre of the dry ingredients. Add water and milk all at once. Mix lightly. Turn out onto a floured surface. Knead lightly. Place on a greased or lined tray that will fit in the frying pan. Pat the dough out to a 15 cm circle. Using a sharp knife, cut two slits across the dough to form a cross approximately 1 cm deep. Brush the top with milk. Sift a little extra flour over the dough. Place some egg rings in the frying pan. Place the tray on top of the egg rings to keep it off the surface of the frypan. Bake in a hot frying pan until golden brown, approximately 10 to 15 minutes.


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Finger puppets

1. Draw your puppets straight onto your fingers with a felt-tipped pen.


2. Draw the faces on a glove or pair of gloves, such as rubber washing-up gloves. Cut the fingers from the gloves so they fit over your fingers.

3. Use rectangles of paper with the faces drawn on them. Glue or sticky tape the ends of the paper together to form cylinders to fit around your fingers.




4. Use old matchbox covers to make finger puppets. Draw the faces on rectangles of paper. The faces should be the size of one side of your matchbox cover. Wrap the paper around the matchbox cover. You could add wool hair over the top of the box and paste at the sides.

Faces on the shorter side



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


Paper plate quails

1. Trace your hands onto paper—twice—then cut out the shapes. These are the quail's tail feathers and feet.




2. Fold a paper plate in half. This is the quail's body.



3. Staple one pair of the hands at one end of the folded paper plate.



- 4. Cut out a circle for the head and small oval for the beak.
- 5. Colour the beak and head, then add eyes.
- 6. Staple the head at the other end of the folded paper plate.
