

After months of being unable to speak, Zechariah the temple priest got his voice back late last night.




He lost his voice some months ago, at around the same time his wife Elizabeth became pregnant. Many people wondered if he would ever speak again.


Zechariah and Elizabeth were so happy last night, with their son John.

Very hot, very dry weather expected throughout the day.



John, born to Elizabeth and Zechariah is getting people ready for the Lord.




Join the dots around Zechariah and Elizabeth. Draw faces on the people and colour in.




- 1. Fold a sheet of A4 paper in half.
- **2.** Fold the half-sheet twice into quarters, then unfold it into a half-sheet again.



3. Fold the top left-hand corner to make a diagonal fold connecting points A and D.


Repeat this with the top right-hand corner to connect points A and B.




4. Take point D and fold it over to the edge of the B fold.

Open again and repeat this with point B, folding it over to the edge of the D fold. Leave this folded.






What is left makes a star window.








HOW TO FOLD A PAPER DOVE.

1. Fold the paper in half and then unfold it.





- **2.** Fold the top corners on the right side into the centre.
- **3.** Bring the two outer edges together.
- **4.** Fold each side in half, down to the original fold you made, to make 'wings'.
- **5.** Fold the two outside 'wings' down.




Note: It may not fly as well once these sections are removed.

- 7. Draw a beak, feathers and eyes onto your dove.
- **8.** Fly your dove. (A paper clip on the beak may help.)






Other seeds fell on rocky ground and started growing. But the plants didn't have enough water and soon dried up.




The rest of the seeds fell on good ground where they grew and produced a hundred times as many seeds.



Some other seeds fell where thorn bushes grew up and choked the plants.







