Each day is based on one short Bible story:


The main course:

- the main meal, all on one plate! Read the Bible story, ask a few questions and pray together. Each meal ends with sticking today's colourful sticker onto the page.

A picture to colour:

- after the main meal, your child may like to colour in the picture on the right-hand page. This is a copy of the sticker and is based on that day's story. As they colour the picture, you might like to talk about it to help your child remember the story they've just read.

Questions

Read out the questions. Make them harder or easier if necessary and do answer them yourself if your child can't answer or is struggling to concentrate. The main aim is not for them to be able to recite answers, but to go back over what has been learned.

Each page gives prayer ideas, using actions to help your child understand. See page 22 for more ideas to help your child to talk to their loving Father God.
