You can ask any question you want and meet other people who are on a similar journey to you.

- Perhaps you have lots of questions to ask, or perhaps you'd rather just to sit and listen.
- You might think of yourself as a confused Christian or a convinced atheist, or somewhere in between...

Christianity Explored is run in a variety of ways. No two groups are the same! Many will have between six and twelve people in them, and have a mixture of ages. Others are run with more people, or it might just be you and a Christian friend. Sessions usually last around a couple of hours and can include:

- food, drink and a time to chat and relax.
- time for you to find out for yourself what the Bible says about Jesus Christ and the meaning of life.
- a short DVD or talk focusing on a part of Jesus' life.
- a discussion time, when you can ask questions or sit and listen to others.

You can say as much or as little as you like. And don't worryyou'll never be asked to sing, pray or read aloud. You don't need to know anything about the Bible either.

And if you need to miss a week, that's ok too. And you can pull out any time you like, for any reason.
