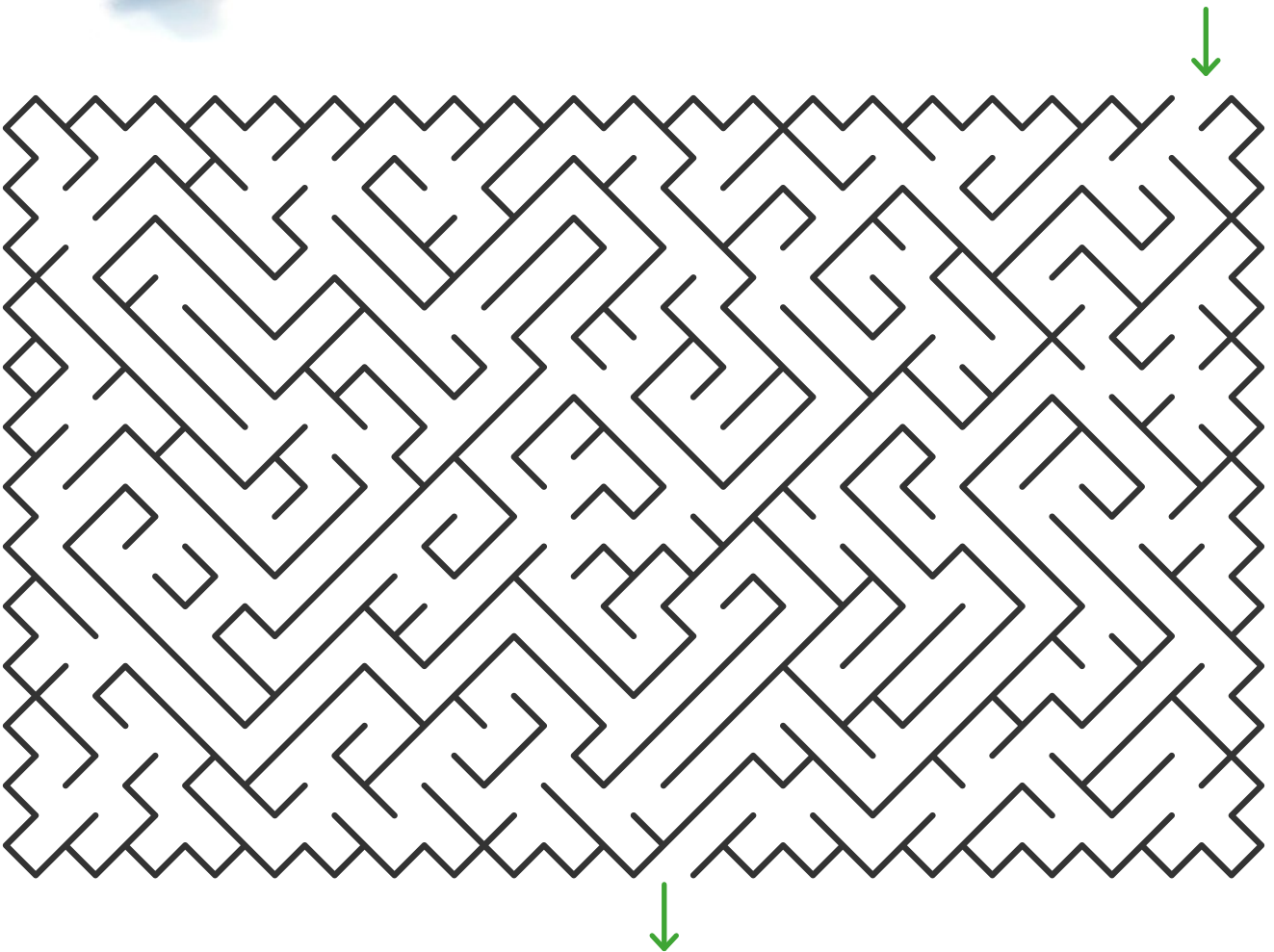


MAZE
